

## **Supply List for Language Arts, Humanities/Literature Grades 5, 6, 7, & 8** (Ms. Amy Caldwell and Ms. Corey Paulson)

### **General Upper School List** - Every student in Grades 5, 6, 7& 8 must have the following:

- A “week-at-a-glance” planner – These show ALL of the days of the week on the two pages when the planner is opened. These are available in many places, but Office Depot has a very good one. This planner can be used for writing assignments for ALL subjects.
- A USB flash-drive (memory stick) with some method to attach it to backpack (keychain?)  
(a second backup for USB is recommended but not required as many students often cannot find theirs)
- A small plastic container for belongings (small enough to fit into a cubby)
- A pen/pencil pouch (plus a separate one for World Languages)
- Reusable water bottle with top

### **SPECIFIC NEEDS** for Language Arts, Humanities/Literature:

- 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> ONLY: ONE 1.5 inch 3-ringed binder with clear plastic cover
- 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> ONLY: The 3-ring binder for Math & Science is enough and will serve for this class as well.
- 5 folders with 3 holes punched in them – These folders must have pockets
- Lined notebook paper
- 3 black and white composition books, college-ruled
- One-subject notebook (with lined paper that tears out, no spirals)
- Pencils with erasers (preferably NOT mechanical) (We need LOTS of pencils!)
- Black & red pens
- Colored markers
- Colored pencils
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Highlighters (2-3 yellow, plus two other colors)
- Post-its
- 3x5 Index cards
- Small box of large paper clips
- Small pencil sharpener
- White-out

**\*During the course of this school year, students in Grade 5, 6, 7 & 8 may be asked to purchase certain novels amounting to approximately \$30-40 for Literature. The titles will be announced in advance with plenty of time to purchase these books.**

**\*It is very helpful for use to have a supply of the following:**

- Tissues
